

Frequently asked questions about applying for Balticlub 2.0

What is the fee for the programme?

There is no fee for the programme. All programme and flight/train/airport bus costs are covered by the organisers. You are only responsible for paying local transport costs in Stockholm, such as a city bus to and from the workshop venue to the hotel.

Am I eligible to apply?

Individuals between the ages 23–33 from Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Russia and Sweden are eligible to apply. We welcome applications from a wide array of professions which involve either entrepreneurship, creative industries or regional cooperation. Whether you are a filmmaker, entrepreneur starting up your own business, working in PR, an artist or working in a regional organization- we welcome you on board!

What will I gain from the event?

You will gain a regional network of likeminded individuals, which you can utilize in your projects, business and any other aspect of your life. Through our excellent workshop leaders and mentors you will also be able to develop your skills when it comes to pitching, project development, culture and arts.

How do I apply?

Send balticlub@cbss.org your CV and 500 words on your passions, current activities and why you would like to be a part of this project.

We welcome creative approaches to the 500 words, so if you would prefer to write us a song, make a video or write 500 words on different objects around town that is fine by us.

Tips for applying:

Combine all your materials into one pdf document. It simplifies our evaluation process and the time it takes for us to get back to all of you! Make sure your name is on at least one page of each document

you send in, including your CV. Make it readable. Text in light colours is difficult, as is putting a dark solid colour behind a lot of small text.

Salutation: If you don't know the person, address the team!

Work: If you're sending a work sample, don't send a ton.
